

CONSENT TO PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

I, the undersigned (hereinafter - the Patient), act of my own free will, volition and for my own benefit, legally capable, I hereby give to OOO "PLATINENTAL" (OGRN 5177746394997, INN 9709020941), located: room 1, unit 1, building 2, 21, Lyalin pereulok, Moscow, 105062, (hereinafter called - Clinic), my consent to personal data processing subject to the terms and conditions set in this consent:

1. This Consent is given for personal data processing with or without automation facilities.
2. The Consent is given for the processing of the following personal data:
Contact phones, e-mail addresses, surname, name, patronymic, passport data, residence registration, driver license data.
3. Personal data are not public.
4. The objective of personal data processing: to process the incoming request in order to make an appointment to the Clinic.
5. The personal data processing is applied relying on the Art. 24 of the Constitution of the Russian Federation, Art. 6 of the Federal Act No. 152-FZ "On personal data", the Company charter OOO "MHC" "Platidental", the present consent to personal data processing.
6. Through the personal data processing the following operations will be accomplished:
collecting, analysis, systematization, storage, specification (updating, change), use, transfer (distribution, reporting, access), blocking, removal, elimination.
7. The personal data is processed once after the Client made his or her request. Personal data processing can be stopped upon the request of the subject of personal data.
8. The Consent can be called away by the subject of personal data or his representatives if he or she sends a written application to OOO "PLATINENTAL" or to the representative, at the address specified at the beginning of this Consent.
9. In case the subject of the personal data or his or her representative calls away the consent to personal data processing of OOO "PLATINENTAL" has the right to continue the processing of personal data without the consent of the subject of personal data if there are sufficient grounds in paragraphs 2-11 of part 1 of article 6, part 2 of article 10 and part 2 of article 11 of the Federal Act No. 152-FZ "On personal data" of 27.07.2006.
10. The present consent is valid indefinitely prior to the termination of personal data processing specified in clauses 7 and 8 of this Consent.
